

## Mobile Outreach Unit

Integral to the Toolbox Talk program is the Fund's Mobile Outreach Unit. The state-of-the-art bus is 42 feet long and able to accommodate 30 people, with additional space for health promotion and screenings. It enables the Health and Safety Fund to effectively reach New England Laborers and LIUNA signatory contractors by offering health and safety initiatives in a classroom setting directly on the job-site. LIUNA Local Business Managers and signatory contractors who wish to utilize the Mobile Outreach Unit can contact the Health and Safety Fund to schedule a visit.

## **Toolbox Talks**

A toolbox talk is a short safety talk or meeting about a specific subject relevant to the work being performed at a jobsite. Although these talks are brief in nature, they are to the point regarding issues that workers are confronted with on a regular basis. They do not replace formal training. A toolbox talk is a hands-on way to remind Laborers about both the importance of being safe and the role workers play in providing for their own safety on the job. Through toolbox talks, the New England Laborers' Health and Safety Fund informs Laborers about health and safety requirements for the equipment, materials and procedures that they use every day or for particular jobs.
